**REPORT ON TALK ON "CANCER AWARENESS AMONG YOUTH-
DETAILS, REMEDIES AND PRECAUTIONS"**

Date: 17.09.2023

The women's forum of SSET conducted a talk on the topic "Cancer Awareness among Youth-Details, Remedies and Precautions". This session was conducted on September 17th, 2023 from 2.00 pm to 3.00 pm at Seminar hall, SSET. Around 95 attendees, including students and faculties of the college. The programme was blessed with the presence of Dr.Philip George Kuttikat, Consultant Medical Oncologist, Apollo Adlux Hospital, the resource person for the event. Ms. Aksa Agi, S5CS1, delivered the welcome speech

Dr.Kuttikat explained the basics of cancer, including its types, and the mechanism of how cancer develops within the body. He used simple language and visuals to make the information accessible to all attendees. He discussed various factors that contribute to the development of cancer, such as genetic predisposition, lifestyle choices (e.g., smoking, diet), and environmental factors (e.g., exposure to carcinogens). Dr. Kuttikat emphasized the importance of preventive measures, including adopting a healthy lifestyle, undergoing regular screenings, and recognizing early warning signs. He also explained the significance of vaccination for certain types of cancer, such as HPV. The speaker provided an overview of cancer treatment modalities, including surgery, chemotherapy, radiation therapy, and immunotherapy. He stressed the importance of early diagnosis in improving the chances of successful treatment.

Dr.Kuttikat highlighted the importance of a support system for cancer patients and their families. He discussed the availability of support groups, counseling services, and informational resources.

The program concluded at 3.00 pm with a vote of thanks delivered by Ms. Ms Jesniya Jose, S5CO. The talk on "Cancer Awareness among Youth" by Dr. Philip George Kuttikat was a resounding success, providing valuable insights into cancer-related issues for the attendees. Dr.Kuttikat's expertise and ability to communicate complex medical information in an understandable manner greatly benefited the audience, particularly the youth.
