
### **KOCHI TRANSPORTATION**

### <u>PUNARJJANI – 6 DAY CAMP</u>

'Punarjjani', a state-wide initiative of the Kerala State Youth Welfare Board and the Technical Cell of the National Service Scheme (NSS), aimed at repairing damaged and out- of-use furniture and other health-care facilities at government hospitals across the State, by making use of the services of NSS Technical Cell volunteers.

The NSS volunteers of SCMS School of Engineering and Technology led by Program Officer Sujay K carried out the Punarjjani camp 2018 at Gandhigram Government Hospital for Dermatology at ayyampuzha primary health centre from 14<sup>th</sup> to 19 <sup>th</sup> July 2018. The camp aimed at bringing the dead equipment and assets of the hospital back to life started way before the camp days.

The hospital was actually built as an isolation area cum hospital for Leprosy patients of south India during the 20<sup>th</sup> century. Even now there are patients who suffer from Leprosy. The people around the hospital kept away from them due to fear of the deadly disease which has now been eradicated. The team recreated assets worth Rupees 59 Lakhs. The volunteers also visited the patients.
