SCHEME FOR ADMISSION TO RESIDENTS OF KARUKUTTY PANCHAYATH

OBJECTIVE :

This scheme is designed to facilitate admission for candidates who are residents of Karukutty Panchayath and wish to pursue B.Tech programme at SSET. Admission under this scheme will be from the seats set apart for Management Quota. One seat in each branch will be set apart for this category.

ELIGIBILITY :

Those seeking admission under this scheme will have to satisfy the following conditions.

1. They have to be permanent residents of Karukutty Panchayath.
2. They should meet the basic minimum eligibility conditions prescribed by SSET for admission to B.Tech programme from time to time. For the 2010 academic year admissions, candidates should have scored atleast 60% marks for Maths and Maths Group at the Plus Two examination. They should also have a valid score in the Entrance Examination conducted by the Commissioner of Entrance Examinations, Government of Kerala. Please note that candidates who are disqualified in the Entrance Examination conducted by the Commissioner of Entrance Examination will not be eligible for admission in SSET under this scheme.
3. Annual income of family should not be more than Rs. 2,50,000/-. (Certificate to this effect from the Village Officer to be provided as required)
4. A certificate from the President / Secretary of the Karukutty Panchayath recommending the candidate for admission is required.
5. Only one seat in each branch will be set apart under this scheme.
6. It is the responsibility of the Panchayath to identify the needy as per guidelines given below and recommend their case for admission. SSET will not in any way be responsible for identifying candidates under this scheme.


Guidelines for Selection of Candidates

- a) The Karukutty Grama Panchayath shall notify the scheme through the notice board of the Panchayath and any other means for information of the public. This notification shall give details of the scheme and also a schedule indicating deadlines for submission and processing of applications.

- b) Application has to be called for from eligible candidates for each branch separately.
- c) Applications received before the last date have to be tabulated and rank list prepared incorporating the details of (i) marks obtained in Maths, Physics, Chemistry for the plus two examination (ii) Marks scored in the entrance examination of the Commissioner of Entrance Examination, Govt. of Kerala (iii) Rank obtained in the entrance examination.
- d) The list so prepared is to be published in the Notice Board of the Panchayath for information of the public.
- e) Eligible candidates, in the order of merit and also based on the annual income are to be recommended by the Panchayath Council for admission.
- f) Complete details including the notification for admission under the scheme, ranklist and copies of applications received, certificate of income and recommendation of the Panchayath Council duly signed by the Secretary/President of the Karukutty Grama Panchayath have to be handed over to SSET for further processing.
- g) Please note that SSET will be able to further process the recommendation of the Panchayath only if all the above particulars are furnished in full as we will be required to furnish this information to the authorities concerned immediately on completion of the admission process.

7. Once admission is confirmed by SSET for a candidate as recommended by the Panchayath it cannot be changed or transferred to any other name under any circumstances.

8. Candidates admitted under this scheme will be eligible for 50% concession in the prescribed annual tuition fee and refundable deposit applicable to students under the management quota.

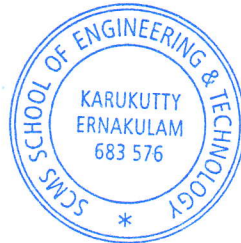

All State governments are hereby advised to ensure the compliance of AICTE scheme on Tuition Fee Waiver as prescribed under point 11 of chapter II of Approval Process Hand Book 2011-12(reproduced below) while admitting to the students in the AICTE approved institutions through competent authority for admission in the state.

11.0			Tuition Fee Waiver scheme (TFW)
	11.1	a	Scheme shall be applicable to all approved technical Institutions offering Bachelor Programs, diploma and Post diploma program of Three/Four years duration
		b	Seats upto maximum 5 percent of sanctioned intake per course shall be available for these admissions. These seats shall be supernumerary in nature.
		c	The Competent Authority for admission shall be the same as for regular admissions.
		d	The scheme shall be mandatory for all Institutions approved by the council.
	11.2		Eligibility
		a	Sons and daughters of parents whose annual income is less than Rs. 2.50 lakhs from all sources shall only be eligible for seats under this scheme
		b	The Waiver is limited to the tuition fee as approved by the State Level Fee committee for self-financing Institutions and by the government for the Government and Government Aided Institutions. All other Fee except tuition fees will have to be paid by the beneficiary.
	11.3		Procedure for Grant of Approval
		a	The Waiver is limited to the tuition fee as approved by the State Level fee Committee for self-financing Institutions and by the Government for the Government and Government Aided Institutions. All other Fee except tuition fees will have to be paid by the beneficiary.
		b	The competent Authority for admission shall be the same as for regular admissions and up to five percent of its sanctioned intake per course shall be available for these admissions. These seats shall be supernumerary in nature.
	11.4		Admissions Procedure
		a	Under this Scheme, up to five percent of sanctioned intake per course shall be available for these admissions. These seats shall be supernumerary in nature.
		b	The competent authority to effect these admissions is the State Government or its designated Authority.
		c	In the event of non-availability of students in this category the same shall not be given to any other category of applications.
		d	State Admission authority shall invite applications under this category, make a separate merit list for this category and effect admissions on the basis of the merit list so generated.
		e	The Institutions shall publish in their brochure and website the details of this scheme.
		f	Competent Authority for admissions shall submit a separate list of the students admitted under this category to the institution to which they are admitted for compliance.
		g	A letter in this respect shall be issued by the competent authority for admissions to each beneficiary student admitted under this scheme and he/she shall not be allowed to change Institution/course under any circumstances
		h	The Institutions shall also display information regarding admitted candidates in their websites for information to the students and other stakeholders.

The scheme is mandatory for all AICTE approved institutions, seats up to maximum 5% of sanctioned intake per course shall be made and these seats shall be supernumerary in nature.

ORDER

The Prospectus for Admission to Professional Degree Courses, Kerala 2020 has been approved by the Government vide Government Order read as first paper above.

As per the clause 1.7 of the Prospectus "Allotment of seats from the Rank lists for all courses in Self-financing Colleges will be made in accordance with the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India /High Court of Kerala or orders of the Government of Kerala/Government of India as per the law in existence at the time of Centralised Allotment Process (CAP) and will be notified separately."

Government vide 2nd paper above entered into an agreement with Kerala Self Financing Engineering College Managements Association (KSFECA) representing 90 (Ninety) Private Engineering College Managements for seat sharing, tuition fee payable, collection of interest-free deposits and other charges for the academic year 2020-21 in respective colleges.

In the circumstances, Government are pleased to approve the agreement and publish the major clauses of the Agreement with regard to the fee structure and allotment of seats for information, appropriate action and compliance by all concerned.

The fee structure applicable to the seats under the categories mentioned below in the Member Colleges, shall be as given below and this annual fees shall be the same for all the four years of study for the student admitted in 2020-21.

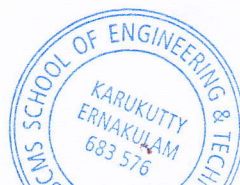
- An applicant can apply only for one category, either management or PIO/FN/Gulf Quota/OCI.
- Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala, or Examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with minimum 45% marks in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry put together & minimum 45% marks in Mathematics separately are eligible for admission under Management Quota.
- Candidates applying for Management Quota should also have a valid rank in the Kerala State Engineering Entrance Examination.
- Scholarships will be provided to candidates considering the 12th standard marks and KEAM Ranks, respectively.
- Semester pass is mandatory for the continuation of scholarships to higher years.

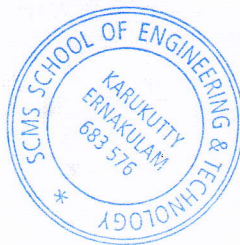

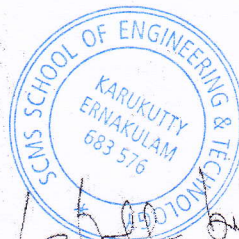
SCMS School of Engineering and Technology has established as one of the premier engineering institutions in our state. Parents and students are keen to get admission and pursue studies in SSET.




- ❖ Sons or daughters of employees only will be eligible for consideration for admission under this scheme.
