panchayat were submerged in the flood. The panchayat has a river margin boundary of 15.5 km. On August 14, 4.73 sq.km of land was flooded while on August 15 an additional 6.30 sq.km of land was submerged and on August 16, 8.5 sq.km of land was destroyed.

Meloor panchayat president P P Babu said: "One of the major challenges before us during the flood was finding the safe path to rescue the stranded people. With the help of a flood map, we can now get a proper idea about all the places which will get submerged first and prioritize the evacuation." "The documentation of the flood reveals that Shantipuram, Poolani, Naduthuruthu, Kalady, and Kuruppam were 90 percent inundated in the flood. Unfortunately, the water level in various regions varied from two feet to a shocking 23 feet. It was in Shantipuram that the water level touched 23 feet. The collected data will also help in deciding the safest camps
