

#### Observations and Recommendations of the committee

After carefully considering all the presented facts, testimonials, evidences such as videos, social media communications, eyewitness accounts and the circumstantial evidences, CSGRC has made the following observations:

1. Mr. Melvin Paul was involved in the fight that happened on March 30<sup>th</sup> 2023 near the main gate of SSET campus. It was not a spontaneous fight but a preplanned execution triggered by the incidents on the previous day (29<sup>th</sup> March 2023) during college sports events. Mr. Melvin Paul played a major role in mobilizing S6 students to beat up two of the junior S4 students Mr. Parvan R. Mahesh and Mr. Anstine Jose during the lunch break. Mr. Melvin Paul also threatened on the possibility of such an incident on the previous night (28<sup>th</sup> March 2023) on his call with Mr. Edwin Isaac Mathew. The threatening of junior students and mobilizing of his batch mates by Mr. Melvin to attack S4 students caused retaliation from S4 students which escalated into a full-blown mob fight between S6 and S4 students on March 30<sup>th</sup> 2023. This resulted in many students getting injured and also cancellation of the sports events and classes in the campus.

Committee therefore identifies Mr. Melvin Paul as the key person whose immaturity, arrogance and will to impose superiority on juniors resulted in the unfortunate events on the campus on March 30th 2023. Throughout the course of conversation with the committee, Melvin kept on changing his statements, multiple times attempting to mislead and confuse the committee which the committee found highly inappropriate.

2. Mr. Alvin A, challenged S8 students leading to the mob fight on March 31st 2023. He was involved in mobilizing S6 students and sharing provocative messages on social media against senior S8 students resulting into a mob fight on the mentioned date. While faculty members were trying to calm down the situation, Mr. Alvin A was found to be busy provoking senior students to hurt their ego and cause more ruckus in the campus. Mr. Jawahar Mohammedali a close aide of Mr. Alvin A was seriously injured in this unfortunate incident and Police cases were taken against many students involved in the mob fight. Academic ambience in the campus was seriously affected and classes had to be suspended for over a week due to these events.

Committee therefore recognizes Mr. Alvin's role as the key perpetrator and strategist in causing these unfortunate events at SSET campus on March 31st 2023.

The Committee is of the view that it is of utmost importance that action strict enough to ensure that students do not cause/instigate such incidents in the future and to make them to understand that such behaviour is unacceptable and can lead to serious consequences be taken.

A brief summary of the involvement of Mr. Melvin Paul and Mr. Alvin A in the incidents leading to disciplinary action against them is as detailed below:

The Annual Sports Week of SSET was scheduled from March 27 to March 31, 2023 from 4 p.m to 6.30 p.m. The events which should have happened with much amount of camaraderie under the sports club of SSET had to be stopped with the Volleyball match between S8 and S4 students on March 29th (Main Referee: Dennis Saji of S6 CS1 and Assistant Referee: Jawahar Mohammed Ali of S6 ME 1) due to an act of indiscipline by Mr. Melvin Paul, wherein he created a ruckus with his junior S4 students and shouted at them to stop cheering for their team. This occurred towards the end of the match point and the Physical Education Director had to interfere and had to stop the match for a moment to avoid a conflict. The match resumed after a while.

Immediately after the match was over Mr. Melvin along with some students of S8 (students from branches excluding S8 ME) continued to create a commotion with Junior S4 students. Mr. Melvin took the lead in arguing with the S4 students for cheering their team in spite of him, a senior, telling them not to do it and he threatened to beat them. This further resulted in a commotion and with the involvement of the faculty it was resolved and everyone dispersed by around 7.30pm. It was also decided by the college to continue with the very next day's sports events, Badminton and Cricket, but due to the events which followed these and those to follow had to be completely cancelled.

Here, the point to note is that S8 ME students of the college are backed up by S4 students and the S6 students are supported by S8 students from branches other than Mechanical Engineering. At the same time these groups do not include the entire students in a particular semester. This groupism to some extent was the result of who supported whom during the Student's Council Elections held during February 2023. But these never resulted in a clash before until this trigger from Mr. Melvin.

The next day, on 30th March 2023, the students of Sixth semester had Aptitude Training by Konfidence for the entire day and both Mr. Alvin A and Mr. Melvin Paul were absent. At around 11.15 pm, Mr. Melvin was on campus near the bike shed along with his allies as part of a planned encounter against the S4 students, especially against those who challenged him the previous day and went ahead with cheering their team. Some students were injured during the ensued fight. Faculty had to interfere and since the situation was serious the Principal had to contact Angamaly Police Station and three police Officers including Devika S, SI of Police were in the campus and premises from 1.36 pm to around 5.30 pm. The class hours for the remaining day (AN) were disrupted, but the classes were not suspended as there was the presence of Police in the campus and hence no further conflict was expected.

Meanwhile the college had identified the problem makers and the Principal by 2.29 pm on the same day, i.e., 30th March 2023, sent out a list of 17 students including Mr. Melvin Paul to the Heads of Departments to inform the students to leave campus and go to their homes until further instructions from college. The parents of the students were also personally informed by the HoDs. This order had to be made to see to the safety of these students considering the amount of problems created by them to their fellow students and to restore the smooth conduct of classes. Throughout these events, the college could also see that there was the element of supremacy which the Senior students wanted to impose on Juniors.

Semester 6 students at the end of the day, that is 30th March 2023, through social media urged their fellow students to come to college on 31st March 2023 but not to attend classes. Mr. Alvin had a lead role in triggering this. Their agenda was to corner students of S8 Mechanical Engineering. This resulted in a further clash between student groups wherein police had to be called again and they were in campus from 1.15pm to 2.35pm. In this fight, few students were injured and resulted in police registering a case against 13 students of S8 ME. These incidents triggered by a few students also resulted in suspending classes from noon of 31st March 2023 to 3rd of April 2023 for S2 B. Tech and S2 PG students and from noon of 31st March 2023 to 8th April 2023 for S4, S6 and S8 Students of B. Tech.

The Principal also filed a complaint in the Cyber Crime Police Station, Aluva on April 6th 2023 and Mr. Alvin A was one among the 5 students who had to report there. Only because the college said not to file a complaint, the officer did not proceed with a charge. er. Melvin was placed under preliminary enquiry from 1st April 2023 and and Mr. Alvin placed under preliminary enquiry with suspension from 1st April 2023. On 4th April 2023, Mr. Melvin Paul and his father reported at college and he was also suspended the same day. Preliminary enquiry of Mr. Alvin was held on 17.04.2023 and detailed enquiry on 26.04.2023.

To prevent further such atrocities from the part of the students between themselves the college had to see to it that the students responsible for conspiring and creating issues be given severe punishment.

Attached, please find the relevant particulars, including the detailed enquiry report.

Mr. Alvin and Mr. Melvin has never submitted a grievance from their end to college. Based on the directions from the Dean Academics, APJAKTU, received yesterday evening, along with the grievances submitted by these two to the University, the report of the CSGRC of SSET will be presented to the Honourable VC within 15 days.





The threatening of junior students and mobilizing of his batch mates by Mr. Melvin to attack S4 students caused retaliation from S4 students which escalated into a full-blown mob fight between S6 and S4 students on March 30th 2023. This resulted in many students getting injured and also cancellation of the sports events and classes in the campus.

Committee therefore identifies Mr. Melvin Paul as the key person whose immaturity, arrogance and will to impose superiority on juniors resulted in the unfortunate events on the campus on March 30th 2023. Throughout the course of conversation with the committee, Melvin kept on changing his statements, multiple times attempting to mislead and confuse the committee which the committee found highly inappropriate.

2. Mr. Alvin A, challenged S8 students leading to the mob fight on March 31st 2023. He was involved in mobilizing S6 students and sharing provocative messages on social media against senior S8 students resulting into a mob fight on the mentioned date. While faculty members were trying to calm down the situation, Mr. Alvin A was found to be busy provoking senior students to hurt their ego and cause more ruckus in the campus. Mr. Jawahar Mohammedali a close aide of Mr. Alvin A was seriously injured in this unfortunate incident and Police cases were taken against many students involved in the mob fight. Academic ambience in the campus was seriously affected and classes had to be suspended for over a week due to these events.

Committee therefore recognizes Mr. Alvin's role as the key perpetrator and strategist in causing these unfortunate events at SSET campus on March 31st 2023.

The Committee is of the view that it is of utmost importance that action strict enough to ensure that students do not cause/instigate such incidents in the future and to make them to understand that such behaviour is unacceptable and can lead to serious consequences be taken.



Mr. Melvin Paul, a student of S6 ME II (Batch 2021-2024) (Reg No. SCM20ME042) has secured 67 percentage attendance for the course MEL334 Thermal Engineering Lab II. He was under suspension for the month of April 2023 due to which he was not able to attend the lab sessions and also condonation cannot be granted during this period. Keeping apart the suspension period he was present for all the lab sessions. Therefore condonation cannot be granted due to unavailability of dates even though medical certificates are provided for the same.

Adding to this, Melvin had requested condonation on 16th March 2023. This was rejected as classes for the above course was not conducted on this date. The concern was well intimated to the Head of the Department and the decision was retained.
