





#### REPORT ON WEBINAR ON GROWING UP GRACEFULLY

Date: 11<sup>th</sup> December, 2020

A webinar on the topic "Growing up Gracefully" was organized for the girl students and lady faculty of the college by the women's forum of SSET. The online session was conducted on 11<sup>th</sup> December, 2020 through google meet and witnessed a participation of around 60 attendees. The program was hosted by Ms. Arshey M, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science, SSET.

Ms. Praveena Kamath, Assistant Professor, Department of EC, SSET introduced the resource person, Ms. Sudha Ajay to the audience. Ms. Sudha Ajay, an alumnus of IITM- Kozhikode is currently working as the associate vice-president of Augmedix, a California based start-up. Over the last 15 years, she has been actively involved in many types of social work apart from discussing and talking to young men and women at various platforms about different topics that subtly play a huge role in life. These experiences brought her closer to interacting with youth and the ability to connect with youth at a much deeper level.

Ms. Sudha Ajay began her talk by detailing the importance of living without prejudices that prevents us to be our real self. She presented a new way of thinking that would help us to be our true self. Deviating from the conventional mode of womanhood and living as a real human being would be the first step of growing up gracefully. Most of the Indian woman lives in the shackles created by society. There are several people who restrict woman by advising about the patriarchal notions that are prevailing in our society for long. As we are going into our real-life circumstances, every woman would have to go through nuances in experience and that would allow us to go through inward and outward conditioning. The limiting thoughts creates boundaries and fences throughout most woman's life. The fear of rejection prevents us from being the true self. Sudha Nair gave an example of a blooming flower as a metaphor to growing up gracefully. Being in the moment and enjoying the situations without a troubled mindset would help you to grow up gracefully was the key concept explained by her.

The program concluded at 7pm with an interactive session of the participants with the resource person. The talk was truly a remarkable one and the thought of believing in tremendous energy and strength in ourselves and the need of self-introspection was imparted to the students for leading graceful life.


