In association with DATRI Blood Stem Cell Donors Registry, a Blood Stem Cell Donation Awareness and Donor Registration Camp was conducted by Smt. Athulya A K, Associate – Donor Recruitment and Counseling.

DATRI is a not-for-profit organization that was founded in 2009 with a mission to save lives of those suffering from life threatening blood disorders like Blood Cancer, Thalassemia, Aplastic Anemia etc. A blood stem cell transplant can save the lives of such patients. With very few registered donors available in India, the possibility of finding a match for an Indian anywhere in the world is very bleak. Inspired by the registries in USA and motivated to create a viable registry of Indian donors, Mr. Raghu Rajagopal together with Dr. Nezih Cereb and Dr. Soo Young Yang of Histogenetics, a global leader in high resolution HLA typing, set up DATRI (meaning donor in Sanskrit) with a donor base of a mere 3000 donors in 2009. DATRI is working towards creating a wide and diverse database of potential blood stem cell donors that can be accessed by any patient, living anywhere in the world, in need of a blood stem cell transplant.

100 NSS volunteers and 20 non- volunteers participated in the event respectively. More than 88 students registered as potential Blood Stem Cell Donors and chose to become potential Life Savers to many suffering from fatal blood disorders.

The idea of conducting such a rare camp was put forward by Blesson Paul, NSS Field Officer. He extended his full support to make our camp most successful and he himself made necessary arrangements to carry it out.
