SCHEME OF 'POST-MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP' FOR STUDENTS BELONGING TOTHE MINORITY COMMUNITIES

ELIGIBILITY

Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh.

DISTRIBUTION

Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Jain and Zoroastrians (Parsis) have been notified as minority communities under Section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992. A total of five (05) lakh scholarships are targeted to be distributed as 'Fresh' Scholarships, besides, Renewal scholarships. The distribution of scholarship among the States/Union Territories will be made on the basis of population of minorities in the States/Union Territories as per Census 2001 for 2017-18 and as per the population of minorities in the States/Union Territories of Census 2011 for 2018-19 and 2019-20 (as per Appendices- A & B).

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Fresh - As the number of scholarships for minorities available in a year is fixed and limited, it is necessary to lay down preference for selection. Inter-se selection weightage is to be given to poverty rather than marks (the applicant is required to submit an income certificate as per para-11(ii)). In case of same income, merit shall be generated from 'Date of Birth' criteria of applicant (senior is preferred).

Renewal – There is no merit list generation for renewal cases. Renewal applicant will get the scholarship if one has obtained 50% in his/her previous year's examinations (at the same institute and in same course) and his/her application is verified by all authorities (as designated by Ministry of Minority Affairs) and approved by State Governments/UTs.

RATES OF SCHOLARSHIP

Actual financial assistance will be provided for admission & course /tuition fee and maintenance allowance as given below subject to a maximum ceiling indicated against item concerned for 2017-20. The details of the scheme interventions for 2017-18 to 2019-20 are as under

RENEWAL OF SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship, once awarded, may be renewed during the next academic year of the course on the production of certificate that the student has secured 50% marks in the previous year's examination (provided the students pursues the same course and same Institute/School).

ANNOUNCEMENT OF SCHEME

The scheme will be announced by the concerned State Government/Union Territory Administration well in time, through advertisements in the leading language newspapers and local dailies and by using other suitable publicity media.

MODE OF APPLYING

The scheme is implemented through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP). It is mandatory for all students to apply online on the website i.e. www.scholarships.gov.in.

PATTERN OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: The scheme is Central Sector Scheme and 100% funding is provided by the Ministry of Minority Affairs.

E-Grantz - A Web-Based Grant Distribution Portal of Kerala

E-Grantz portal is a dedicated online portal run by the SC/ST/OBC Development Departments of Government of Kerala for centralised disbursement of scholarships and stipends to students within the state. The portal allows the students belonging to reserved categories to apply for the scholarships available at post-matriculation level online. Also, if a student is unable to submit the online application, the **E-Grantz** portal provides the provision for the institutions to enter the application on student's behalf. Over the years, the portal has benefitted over 3 Lakh students studying across 3400+ institutions in Kerala. However, with the launch of its new version named E-Grantz 3.0, it is expected to influence the lives of many more deserving students.

The E-Grantz portal only enlists post-matric scholarship for the students belonging to SC, OBC, OEC and other economically and socially backward classes. The amount of financial assistance that is given to students through these schemes varies based on your category and current academic qualification. Furthermore, with the help of this advanced platform, the selected students receive the scholarship amount directly into their account through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT).

Application Timeline: Within a week of taking an admission in any of the courses listed.

E-Grantz - Key Eligibility

The scholarships and schemes available on the E-Grantz portal have a pre-defined set of eligibility conditions that you need to fulfil to apply for them. These conditions are primarily based on your current academic qualification, domicile, the category to which you belong and family income. The table below highlights detailed eligibility conditions for the scholarships available on E-Grantz. Depending on your fulfilment of these conditions, you can move ahead and apply for them as specified.

GATE Scholarship: Eligibility, Steps to Apply and Document Required

GATE Scholarship is a merit scholarship offered to first-year candidates who have qualified GATE exam. Students seeking admission in the academic year 2021-22 can expect the scholarship registration to start in the second week of December 2021. An amount of INR 12,400 is offered to qualified candidates for a duration of 24 months or for the overall duration of the course, whichever is of a lesser duration. Eligible courses include M.E/M.Tech./M.Pharm./M.Arch.

- The scholarship would be only for the AICTE approved colleges.
- Candidates need to login on to the scholarship page using their unique ID, as provided by the institute during the time of registration. Then they will then have to upload the required documents and submit their application.
- Candidates are advised to download the GATE scorecard as it is one of the major documents required to avail of the scholarship.

GATE Scolarship Eligibility

GATE Scholarship: Eligibility Criteria

The first and major requirement for the candidates to be entitled to GATE scholarship is to have a valid GATE score at the time of admission into their desired course. Students who do not have a valid score card when they get admitted in the course or those students who qualify the examination after the day of admission has passed will not be eligible to apply for the scholarship.

Here are the detailed eligibility criteria for the GATE scholarship by AICTE to help the candidates:

Eligible:

- At the time of admission to the course, the candidates must produce their valid GATE scorecard released after score normalization. Also Check GATE Score Calculation
- To receive the amount of the scholarship, a general saving bank account in the name of the candidate should exist.
- All the candidates falling under the SC/ST/OBC (Non-creamy layer)/ Physically Handicapped/ Differently Abled are eligible to apply for the scholarship only if they have an authentic caste/required certificate.

Not Eligible:

- In case the students have taken admission before or after the validity of GATE score, their candidature for the scholarship will not be accepted. What is the Validity of GATE Score?
- The scholarship will not be granted to those who have already completed their post-graduation.
- Candidates who have taken admission into the postgraduate programs through management quota, sponsored candidates, and foreign candidates are not eligible to apply for the scholarship.
- Any kind of joint accounts or accounts under the guardian's names are not allowed for the GATE scholarship.
- Students who have taken admission into part-time postgraduate courses are not eligible for the scholarship.
- In the absence of a valid certificate, the students will not be considered eligible.
- Applicants from the OBC category, who belong to the creamy layer under the OBC category, are not eligible for applying to
 the scholarship for GATE.
- If a candidate has already availed the scholarship from IIT, NIT then he/she will not be considered eligible for AICTE scholarship.

Once the candidates fulfill all the eligibility criteria and qualify for the scholarship, the amount will be deposited to their bank accounts every month for a period of 2 years or till the date of completion of courses they are pursuing, whichever is earlier.

CENTRAL SECTOR SCHEME OF SCHOLARSHIP FOR COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY STUDENTS

ELIGIBILITY

Students who are above 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream from the respective Board of Examination in Class XII of 10+2 pattern or equivalent and pursuing regular courses (not correspondence or distance mode) in Colleges/Institutions recognized by All India Council of Technical Education, UGC Act, 1956, Medical Council of India, Dental Council of India and respective regulatory authorities and not availing benefit of any other scholarship scheme including State run scholarship schemes/Fee waiver and reimbursement scheme are eligible under the scheme. Students pursuing Diploma courses are not eligible under the scheme.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE SCHEME AND SELECTION PROCEDURE

National Scholarship Portal (NSP) www.scholarships.gov.in will be opened for online application in the month of June-July every year

RATE OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

The rate of scholarship is Rs.10000/- per annum at Graduation level for first three years of College and University courses and Rs.20000/- per annum at Post Graduation level. Students pursuing professional courses, in case, where the duration of course is five (5) years/Integrated course would get Rs.20000/- per annum in the 4th and 5th year. However, students pursuing technical courses such as B.Tech., B.Engg would get scholarship up to graduation level

PARENTAL INCOME CEILING:

The parental/family income ceiling is Rs. 8 lakh per annum for all categories under the scheme and would be applicable from the Academic Session 2018-19. Income certificate would be required for the fresh applicants only
