SSET-IQAC organised a webinar on Implementation of National Education **Policy (NEP) 2020** on 28th May 2021. The speaker for the webinar was Dr. Dulari S S, Associate Professor, SCMS School of Technology and Management. The participants of the webinar were faculty members, Technical staff members and students and there were around 250 participants.

The two main objectives of this webinar was:

- to create awareness about the newly launched National Education Policy 2020 amongst teachers, students, officials, and other stakeholders in the higher education system.
- Implementation of NEP 2020 in the Institution.

Dr. Praveensal C J Principal welcomed the gathering and introduced the speaker. Following him the speaker detailed the vision and key principles of NEP 2020. She mentioned that the Universalisation of education from preschool to secondary level with 100% GER will be implemented by 2030. The current system 10+ 2 system in school education is to be replaced by a new 5+3+3+4 structure corresponding to ages 3-8, 8-11,11-14 & 14-18 years. School governance is set to change with a new accreditation framework & an independent authority to regulate both public & private sector. She welcomed the various recommendations of New Education Policy as flexible exam pattern, universalization of early childhood care education and integration of curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular curriculum.

NEP 2020 Aims to increase the GER in higher education to 50% by 2035. NEP 2020 is the transformative nature that is transform all under graduate institutions into multidisciplinary institution. All undergraduate programmes are aimed at holistic development that is development of intellectual, aesthetic, physical, social, moral, ethical and soon and all must be done in an integrated manner. Dr. Dulari gave detailed description about technological context and application in education, curricular reforms, holistic development, development of cognitive process, value development and assessment. There will be Graded accreditation system for granting Graded Autonomy to colleges and Every college would develop into either an autonomous degree-granting college or a constituent college of a university.

Time span for implementation of NEP 2020 is nearly 20 years and Implementation will be done in phases, based on time, region & types of institutions with Institutes of Eminence (IoEs) & Central Universities.

For the successful start of implementation of NEP 2020 Dr. Dulari mentioned that the institution must aim to develop good, thoughtful, well-rounded, and creative individuals. It must enable an individual to study one or more specialized areas of interest at a deep level, and also develop character, ethical and Constitutional values, intellectual curiosity, scientific temper, creativity, spirit of service, and 21st century capabilities across a range of disciplines including sciences, social sciences, arts, humanities, languages, as well as professional, technical, and vocational subjects. A quality higher education must enable personal accomplishment and enlightenment, constructive public engagement,

and productive contribution to the society. It must prepare students for more meaningful and satisfying lives and work roles and enable economic independence.
