Games 2019 DAYS GONE

1.DAYS GONE(22 FEB 2019)

Days Gone is an upcoming action-adventure game developed by SIE Bend Studio and published by Sony Interactive Entertainment. It is scheduled to be released exclusively for PlayStation 4.

Call of Duty: Black Ops 4 is a multiplayer first-person shooter developed by Treyarch and published by Activision. It was released worldwide on October 12, 2018, for Microsoft Windows, PlayStation 4 and Xbox One

Hitman 2 is an upcoming stealth video game developed by IO Interactive and published by Warner Bros. Interactive Entertainment for Microsoft Windows, PlayStation 4, and Xbox One. It will be the seventh entry in the Hitman video game series and is the sequel to the 2016 game Hitman.

4.METRO EXODUS(22 FEB 2019)

Metro Exodus is an upcoming first-person shooter video game developed by the Ukrainian Malta-based studio 4A Games and published by Deep Silver. It is the third installment in the Metro video game series based on Dmitry Glukhovsky's novels. It is set to follow the events of Metro 2033 and Metro: Last Light.

5.ANTHEM(22 FEB 2019)

Anthem is an upcoming online multiplayer action role-playing video game being developed by BioWare and published by Electronic Arts. The game is slated for a worldwide release for Microsoft Windows. PlayStation 4 and Xbox One on February 22, 2019.



Crypto Anchors

Levitating lamp

Flyte is a wireless light bulb floating in the air above a small wooden base in which magnets are embedded.

This lamp is already actively used because it takes surprisingly little energy: if it's on for 6 hours per day. the lamp can work for as long as 22 years.

Self flying speaker

A cross between a speaker and an autonomous flight drone, the device can answer all your queries just like a Google Home, all while following you around the house. That way, you don't need to have a different intelligent speaker in every room – this thing will just follow as you move from the living room to the kitchen all the way to the bedroom.

Virtual keyboard

An optical virtual keyboard was invented and patented by IBM engineers in 2008. It optically detects and analyses human hand and finger motions and interpreted on a physically non-existent input device like a surface having painted keys. In that way it allows to emulate unlimited types of manually operated input devices such as mouse or keyboard. All mechanical input units can be replaced by such virtual devices, optimized for the current application and for the user's physiology maintaining speed, simplicity and unambiguity of manual data input.

Android 9 "Pie" is the ninth major update and the 16th version of the Android operating system. Android Pie, then referred to as "Android P" was first announced by Google on March 7, 2018, and the first developer preview was released on the same day. "Android Pie" was officially released on August 6, 2018, as "Android 9 Pie" and is currently available for Google Pixel devices, the OnePlus 6, Nokia 7 + and the Essential Phone. Google announced it will release Android 9 Pie (Go Edition), the lite version of Android Pie, in autumn.

This version of Android restricts access to mic, camera, and all SensorManager sensors from apps that are idle according to Google. This means that even if you've granted permission for an app to access your microphone, it can't do so unless you're actively using it.
