(B) *Details of fees to be remitted at the time of Enrollment at the College.*

(C) *Hostel accommodation (available for Boys & Girls)*

Those requiring hostel accommodations have to fill up the application form and remit the following fees.

Hostel caution deposit (Refundable)	- Rs. 5,000/-*	} Rs. 11,255/-
Advance Hostel Rent for one month	- Rs. 2,000/-	
One month advance towards mess fee	- Rs. 4,255/-	

Note: On vacating the hostel, student should take hostel clearance from warden and vacate the room on the same day itself.

(D) **Transportation.**

Those requiring transport facility by College bus have to fill up the form and remit the fee for six months. Transport facility will be available from Vytilla, Thripunithura (Seaport Airport road), Thoppumpady, Valanjambalam, GCDA, Palarivattom, High Court Junction, Vaduthala, Perumbavoor, Paravur, Kodungallur Irinjalakuda, Pukkattupady, Muvattupuzha and Thrissur to College and back.

Note: On cancelling the bus facility, student should return the bus pass along with cancellation letter to principal.

Mode of fee collection and refund to students who are admitted under Government Allotment.
