ADMISSION STANDARDS

The following admission standards will be used to screen students from SCMS :

- Applicants should have the equivalent of a U.S. bachelor's degree*.

*: Those who do not have a 4-year Indian degree must submit a certificate of completion for

Pre-MBA coursework consisting of at least 30 credit hours to be completed at SCMS.

- Applicants should have earned a minimum 3.0 undergraduate grade point average on a scale of 4.0. (Applicants with an undergraduate overall GPA under 3.0 must have three years of professional work experience.)
- A satisfactory score in English Language Proficiency include TOEFL iBT equal to 79 (550 paper-based) or above, or IELTS equal to 6.5 or above or Duolingo test scores of at least 105.
- Leadership potential demonstrated through work experience, community service, research projects, extracurricular activities, or other acceptable means.
- Meritorious candidates who do not meet the above standards will be interviewed and evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

HOW TO APPLY ?

FOR SCMS APPLICATION

- Apply via <https://admissions.scms.edu.in/> (please pick NKU MBA)
- Upload Statement of Purpose, Official transcripts from each institution attended earlier.

FEES

- Tuition fee for this MBA program is \$10,000 payable to NKU. The cost does not include NKU mandatory fees, the cost of having transcripts evaluated, and the cost of textbooks or other materials. The cost also does not cover the additional tuition for extra classes to obtain the 3.00 GPA required for graduation.
- SCMS Fee of INR 3,00,000 is payable to SCMS in 2 instalments. This does not include SCMS Examination fees and living expenses.
- Students traveling to NKU's Highland Heights campus to complete their degree will be responsible for paying all other fees and expenses, including but not limited to travel expenses, living expenses, and fees associated with the acquisition of a visa and other expenses while in the U.S. Also, NKU requires international students at NKU's campus to have personal health insurance through the University.

CURRICULUM AND DELIVERY METHOD

The program is 33 credit hours and will be offered as follows :

- SCMS AACSB qualified faculty will teach 8 MBA courses (14 credit hours) at the SCMS campus in Kerala, India. NKU will grant credential to SCMS faculty teaching in this program.
- NKU faculty members will teach 19 credit hours** at NKU's campus (Highland Heights, KY).
- The overall program will take 18-24 months to complete.

** : Specialization courses offered by NKU faculty on Supply Chain, Marketing, Analytics and Finance.
