TIME- 2 to 4.30pm



We started our conference on 14th November 2021 with a session on Vaccine Development by Dr. S. S. Lal MBBS, MBA, MPH, PhD. He talked about the recent need for vaccine development considering our pandemic situation. He also talked about the most recent advances in vaccine development leading to the working of some of the COVID-19 vaccines available in the country. Dr. PadmanabhaShenoyMD, DM further talked about the "Effect of COVID-19 vaccines in Immunosuppressed patients". He discussed various myths and rumors regarding COVID-19 vaccines. He was also able to clarify a few questions regarding the myths of COVID-19 vaccines during the Q&A session. On Day 2, Dr. ParameswaranHari MD, MRCP, MS handled a session on "Prevalence of tuberculosis in India despite health care measures". He talked about air borne diseases and our limitations to contain the disease. He also talked about the similarities between tuberculosis and COVID-19. He concluded by giving us awareness on how to contain the disease and the precautions that should be taken against the disease. Day 3 was commenced by Dr. E SreekumarMVSc, PhD who talked on "The lessons from the pandemic: Implications for the medical and biotechnological field". He started the session on the outbreak of COVID-19. He also talked about the 2nd and 3rd wave and the reason for the same. He concluded by talking about the lessons that we can learn from the pandemic so that we can avoid any future pandemics. We had a total of 250 participants for the conference.





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On Job Training on Mushroom Farming




