



Despite the chemical and biochemical analysis of the therapeutic properties of herbs, the molecular evidence for detecting the mode of action of natural drugs has been a novel trend of research today. Hemigraphis alternata, a tropical herb of Acanthaceae family has gained sufficient therapeutic attention in folklore medicines as a potent phyto-medicine for wound healing. Wound healing is a complex and protracted process of tissue repair and remodeling. Each phase of repair requires presence of certain growth factors, cytokines and immune cells to accelerate healing process. Transforming Growth Factor Beta 1 (TGF βI) is one such growth factor which plays an effective role in wound healing. In the present study, an attempt was made to reveal the molecular mechanism of the wound healing effect of H. alternata leaf extract (HALE) fractions separated by silica-based column chromatography. Nine fractions were collected and each fraction was treated on in vitro scratch wound model cell line cultures of Human Embryonic Kidney (HEK) 293 cells for determining wound closure rate at an interval of 24 hours. It was obvious from the data that the Fractions 8 and 9 showed higher wound closure. The
