






1. UBA B.Com

The department of Commerce at SCMS College, Muttom, has chosen Choornikara as its local body partner for project implementation. Departmental Committee consists of two faculty members, Ms. SindhuManoj and Ms. Gifi Felix. On 14/01/2019, a pilot survey was conducted in 6 houses randomly chosen from Ward XV. As a part of household survey under UBA, a team of 14 students from B.Com (second semester) assisted by the faculty coordinators visited 44 households in the Choornikkara ward on February 25th and collected the information through questionnaire. The next field visit for UBA was conducted on 5th and 6th March 2019. Faculty coordinators met Village Officer, Panchayat President, Agricultural Officer and visited the hospitals at Choornikkara, as part of Village survey and collected the required information. Mrs. Safiya Ali, Ward Member, also helped to make the task easier. A meeting was scheduled with BabuPuthanangady, Choornikkara Panchayat President, at the Principal's chamber, SSTM, Muttom campus on Wednesday, 3rd July 2019. Safiya Ali, ward member, and staff co- ordinators, Ms.SindhuManoj and Ms.Gifi Felix also attended the meeting. The aim of the discussion was to formulate different developmental activities at the Panchayat level with the help of SSTM Cochin. After the discussion with Directors a decision has been made to foster the developmental works of the Panchayath. As a part of this program, Skill Development Training was conducted for the women of Choonikkara Panchayat (Ward no .15) on Friday, 20th September 2019. In addition to this, the students of SSTM, Cochin along with 'Adayalam'(a youth organization to promote agriculture) under the leadership of Ms.SindhuManoj and Ms.Gifi Felix, went to Kattepaadam, Muttom with the motive of cleaning the place and to build a resting place for the farmers.

2. UBA MBA

3. UBA MCA

On 29-12-2018,Ms Sudha D and MsAnupamaUsha ,faculties from the department of MCA met the President of the panchayat ,MsSajitha Abbas of Edathala Village and discussed about the UBA (UnnatBharathAbhiyan) initiative of the government for the progress of the nation .She expressed her willingness to cooperate with the survey process and allotted two wards ,numbered 15 and 8 and of which, ward 15 was chosen for the survey to be conducted by the Department of MCA.On January 2nd MsSudha D and MsAnupamaUsha ,faculties from the department of MCA conducted a mock survey South vazhakulam, Edathala panchayath ,15th ward. The residence of the ward cooperated well to collect the data.On march 1, 2019 the students of MCA Department went to South vazhakulam, Edathala panchayath ,15th ward. The purpose of the visit was to conduct a survey in the households as per the UnnathBharathAbhiyan Scheme of MHRD Government of India.

On 4thjuly 2019 as per our invitation Panchayath President of Edathala Gramapanchyath, Mrs.Sajitha Abbas and Councillor of ward 15, Mr.Mayadasan arrived in SCMS and discussed about the problems facing by the residents. At the end of the meeting Principal requested their cooperation to implement the project which will be finalized by the Director after the discussion. After the discussion with Director Department of MCA decided to implement the Panchayath Development work as "Literacy Programme for the benefit of residents of the ward no 15".

It is a 5 day programme, 2 hr per day and the venue to conduct the programme was Govt Nursery hall, Muthirakkattumughal and the programme will be finished in 5 days. Total 7 students will be participated and one faculty from the department.

4. UBA BA

UBA is a flagship programme sponsored by the MHRD and governed through a national steering committee and IIT Delhi which functions as the apex coordinating institute. SCMNS is one of the major participating institution and colleges has identified five panchayats in the state of Kerala. The department of Economics at SCMS has chosen Chengamanad as its local body partner for project
