




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STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY



A student satisfaction survey was conducted, with 39% of responses received from Postgraduate students and 61% from Undergraduate students.





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How satisfied you are with the facilities provided by the college?



66% of students reported being satisfied with the facilities provided by the college.





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A substantial 75% of students rated the faculty members as very supportive. This reflects the conducive environment extended by faculty for learning.





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A total of 97% of students reported that faculty and support staffs at the college were helpful, indicating a positive perception of their assistance.





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90% of students responded that the college regularly schedules internal assessments, showing the institution's commitment to a structured assessment process.









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Are you satisfied with the library timings and resources?



A total of 65% of students expressed satisfaction with the library's hours of operation and resources, indicating that they find the library both accessible and well-stocked with relevant materials.





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A total of 60% of students expressed their satisfaction with the online classes. They found that the online sessions are effective and engaging.





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A total of 92% of students reported that teachers are prepared for the class. This indicates that teachers are well-prepared and ready to deliver effective lessons.





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A total of 72% of students reported that teachers are always effective in their communication. A majority of students perceive that their teachers are clear and engaging, demonstrating strong communication skills.





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The teachers approach to teaching can best be described as



A total of 97% of students described their teachers' approach to teaching as good, effective and engaging. This reflects positively on the overall teaching quality.





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The Institutional Involvement in placement activities.



A total of 72% of students reported that the institution engages in placement activities. This reflects positively on the institution's commitment to support students in their transition to the workforce.





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The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates in cognitive, social and emotional growth





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
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A total of 64% of students agree that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. This implies that students feel well-supported and satisfied with the resources available for their development.




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A total of 67% of students agree that teachers encourage participation in extracurricular activities. There is a clear sense that many students feel supported in pursuing activities beyond the classroom.





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What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LED projector, Multimedia, etc., while teaching?



A total of 90% of teachers use ICT tools, such as LED projectors and multimedia, during teaching, indicating that the institution is adapting to modern educational practices.





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A total of 66% of students rated the overall quality of the teaching-learning process of the institute as satisfactory.




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
