WEBINAR ON EMERGING AND RE-EMERGING INFECTIOUS DISEASES – A THREAT TO HUMANITY


REPORT

On August 29, 2022, a webinar titled "Emerging and Re-emerging Infectious Diseases – A Threat to Humanity" was conducted by Dr. R. Sajith Kumar, Professor Emeritus at Kottayam Medical College. Organized by the Department of Bioscience and Biotechnology at SCMS School of Technology and Management in association with IQAC, the session ran from 3:30 PM to 4:30 PM via Zoom.

Dr. Kumar opened the session by defining emerging infectious diseases as those that have recently appeared in populations or are rapidly increasing in incidence, while re-emerging diseases are those that were once under control but are now resurfacing. He cited significant examples, including COVID-19, Zika virus, and Ebola, discussing their origins, modes of transmission, and the broader implications for public health. The presentation highlighted various factors contributing to the rise of these diseases, such as urbanization, climate change, and increased human-animal interactions, as well as globalization.

Emphasizing the global health threat posed by these diseases, Dr. Kumar stressed the need for international collaboration in surveillance and response efforts. He discussed the importance of preparedness and response strategies, advocating for enhanced surveillance systems, rapid response frameworks, and investments in research for vaccine development. The role of biotechnology in creating diagnostics, treatments, and vaccines was also emphasized as a crucial area in combating infectious diseases.
