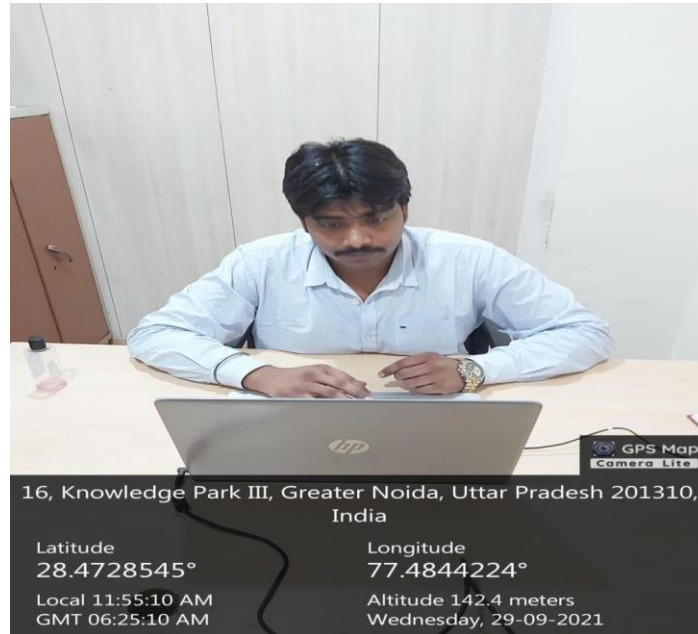

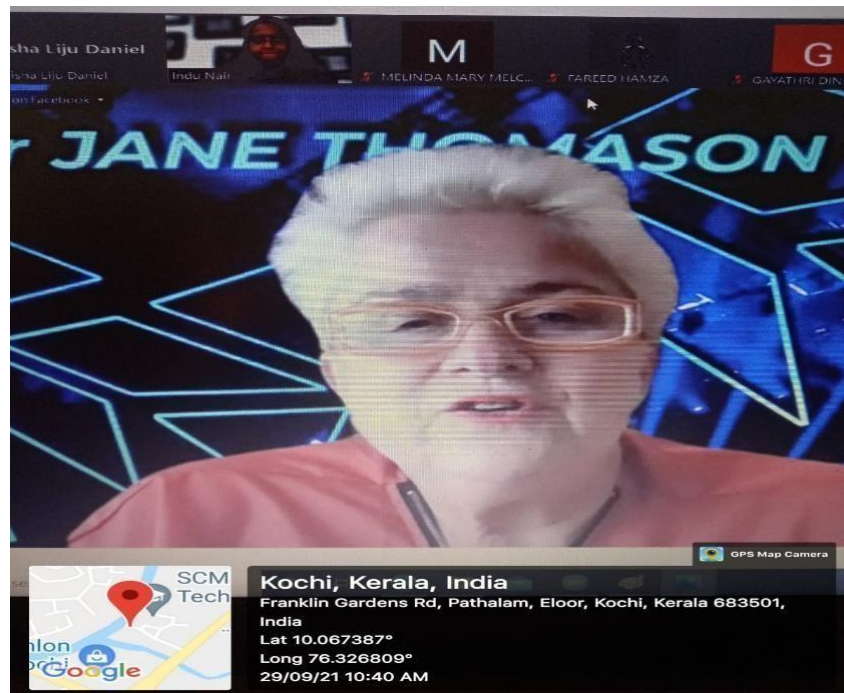

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International conference on “Recent Advances in Infectious Disease Research and Epidemiology”

TOPIC: Recent Advances in Infectious Disease Research and Epidemiology

DATE- 14 – 16-November, 2021

SCMS Institute of Bioscience and Biotechnology R&D (SIBB R&D) organized an Online International Conference on "Recent Advances in Infectious Disease Research and Epidemiology" on 14-16 November 2021. We started our conference on 14th November 2021 with a session on Vaccine Development by Dr. S. S. Lal MBBS, MBA, MPH, PhD. He started the session on the outbreak of COVID-19. He also talked about the 2nd and 3rd wave and the reason for the same. He concluded by talking about the lessons that we can learn from the pandemic so that we can avoid any future pandemics. We had a total of 250 participants for the conference.

Declaration: A written declaration from the respective author(s) of the papers should be forwarded along with the full paper for authenticity. Self-attested plagiarism-free certification should be attached.

Dr. Radha P Thevanoor, convener ICAW and Director of SCMS group, rendered the welcome speech for the delegates.



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Meet at SCMS discusses security for the elderly

Old age is a great time to sit back and enjoy life and remaining happy is a significant contributor to healthy aging. The fourth Biennial International Conference on Aging Well, held at SCMS College in Kochi, provided a platform for professionals involved in senior care, educators and researchers to discuss innovative ideas to help the elderly live independently and securely. The focus of the discussions included geriatrics, gerontology, geronto management and public policies.

Though geriatric care is vital to any nation, only extrapolated data is available in India, said SCMS Group of Educational Institutions director Radha Thevannoor, convener of the conference. "Nobody in our country openly speaks about ageing. They don't consider it a serious matter as the youth constitute most of our population and their concerns matter more than that of the aged" she said. Ageing is inevitable but it is also a very sensitive phase in one's life. During this time they are both physically and emotionally weak. They feel isolated and neglected by their younger generation.




"Around 12.8% of Kerala's population and 5.3% of India's population is above the age of 65. This number causes a major concern. Until a person is healthy, ageing should not be considered a burden. The older generation should learn to enjoy their lives before they get confined to a bed," said Radha. Kerala University Sociology Department assistant professor Chitra S Nair made a presentation on self and social identity of aged women. "Elderly women generally would like to act normal and usual as any other woman of a lesser age. But they shy away from performing due to social stigma. Widows usually wear pale and plain sarrees and avoid wearing jewellery. Social identity sometimes takes over self-identity and this negatively affects the elderly who are in depression," she said.

The conference was mainly aimed at making the MBA students of SCMS School of Technology and Management aware of the problems faced by their grandparents and support them. "This is a very good initiative. We get to know about the problems the aged face and we try to relate more with them" said a student.



National Seminar on Imperatives for Managing Plastic Waste

Report

SCMS School of Technology and Management (SSTM) organized a National Seminar on Imperatives for Managing Plastic Waste on 12th October 2018 co-sponsored by Kerala State Council for Science, Technology and Environment (KSCSTE). The objective of the seminar was to sensitize the participants on the approach to designing, producing and using plastic products. The seminar was attended by 50 participants (faculty and students of engineering colleges and biotechnology).

Introductory remarks:

Dr. Susan Abraham, Professor, SSTM welcomed all the participants to the Seminar and thanked Dr. Nirmala Padmanabhan, Associate Professor, St. Teresa's College for agreeing to give the keynote address in spite of her busy schedule. Dr. Sashi Kumar, Principal, SSTM presided over the function and Prof. Gopakumar S, Group Director, SCMS Group of Institutions delivered the Inaugural address.

Dr. G Sashi Kumar, Principal, SSTM in his address quoted incidents where the use of plastics led to serious health problems. He highlighted the extent of use of plastics in our daily lives. In his Inaugural address, Prof Gopakumar S, Group Director, SCMS Group of Institutions explained the need for recycling and reuse of plastic products. He reiterated the need to avoid using plastic products and the need to use biodegradable products.

Keynote address 1:

Dr. Nirmala Padmanabhan, Associate Professor, PG Department and Research in Economics, St. Teresa's College, Ernakulam gave the first keynote address in the seminar. In her address she mentioned many incidents where plastic was found in deep sea and has entered into the aquatic food chain. The issue is the indiscriminate use of single use plastic and tons of such used plastic is dumped on land and sea. The waste audit done in four panchayats in Kerala reveal that the plastic bottles and sanitary napkins form the major components in waste. In these panchayats, no measures have been taken to process or manage the waste. The overall impact is that human health is affected by ailments leading to


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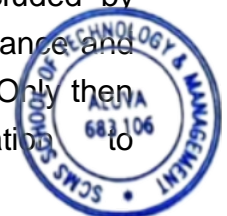
death, ground water being polluted as chemicals used in plastic percolates into the soil. Dr. Nirmala Padmanabhan stressed the point that the focus should shift to reducing and banning the production of plastic. She suggested certain measures to managing plastic waste.

1. People should gradually reduce the consumption of plastic per person.
2. Adopting green protocol in all institutions as initiated by Kerala State Government.
3. Plastic waste can be reduced by cutting down on the production of plastic.
4. Plastic waste which cannot be recycled has to be up cycled to make household products such as shopping bags, handbags, wallets and so on.
5. Campaigns such as 'Say No to Plastic Bag' can be undertaken frequently.

She concluded by saying that youth can become brand ambassadors of ecofriendly alternatives and it can be achieved through proper awareness of reducing the usage of single used plastics. She also emphasized on the fact that institutions need to take proper action.

Mr. Sooraj Abraham, Co-founder, Plan@Earth was the second resource person in the seminar. He listed the types of plastic waste that cannot be recycled. According to him major plastic waste contributors are e-commerce businesses using tons of plastic for product packaging. While explaining the steps in managing waste, he focused on the necessity for people to take the responsibility for reducing the consumption of plastic and follow the 3R's (recycle, reuse, refuse). He stressed that plastic producers must pay for the consequences. Organisations engaged in the business of recycling plastic waste must give emphasis to collecting cleaned and sorted plastic waste and up cycle the residual non-recyclables. He mentioned that don't try to laminate our Earth by increasing usage of plastics. He also exhibited many household items that were made of plastic waste like bags, files, pouches and so on. Further he pointed out various business opportunities in the field of waste management. He concluded by saying that any social change has three phases – Awareness, Acceptance and Action. Managing plastic waste has to be every citizen's responsibility. Only then our Earth can be conserved for the next generation to live.


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The third keynote speaker, Dr. C N Manoj, Co-founder, Pelican Foundation, Cherthala said that people in general have low level of awareness of waste generation and management. Waste does not create infections. He stressed the need to reduce waste production at each house. When biodegradable waste is managed at every house, cleaner surroundings and self-reliance can be ensured, it is the youth who have to create awareness about managing waste at each household. He also stated that like-minded people need to form various formal and informal groups and undertakes initiatives to reduce the usage of plastics in the society. There is a need to bring in a transformation in the society where citizens should decide on the choices to be made; moving on to products that not cause health issues; and influence others to change.

Way forward and Summing up:

There were questions raised to the resource persons by the members of the audience. Alternatives to plastic products were discussed and the imperatives for business startups in plastic waste recycling and reuse were deliberated. Audience raised queries related with the availability of these up cycled products and resource persons shared details about these products. Another valid point came up in the discussions were the producers are responsible for the production of these plastic items and they need to be accountable for the reuse & reduce of these plastic items. At present the herculean task of waste management lies only on the shoulders of end user, that practice need to be changed and big manufacturing houses need to take initiatives for the Reuse, reduce and re-cycle of their products. Thereby we can decrease the level of plastic waste and ensure plastic free environment. The resource persons invited the participants of the seminar to volunteer to bring in a change in their neighborhoods. Ms. Devi S Nair, Assistant Professor, SSTM summarized the day's proceedings and thanked all the resource persons for sharing their innovative ideas with the participants.

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

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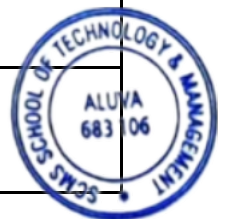

The faculty and students of B.Sc Botany & Biotechnology and M.Sc Molecular Biology & Genetic Engineering were the participants. “ in my profession I use technology for the benefit of the mankind,” said Dr. H.V Easwer. Development of technology began millions of years ago when man used to live in caves. Homo sapiens were better than all other species of man and all other animal species because of one reason, the brain. Referring to the book Sapiens, A Brief History of Humankind, authored by the Jewish historian Yuval Noah Harari, he said that human beings were able to work together, develop new things and develop science and technology which made us the master of the herd. The first development of technology happened when man somehow discovered fire. The human intelligence did not stop at that. They learned to recreate the genesis of fire by using two stones-the first scientific technology they invented. Use of technology for the benefit of mankind started with the evolution of man. Then, one of the greatest scientific developments happened - the invention to the wheel. It made is possible for us to travel from one place to another. Today it is not only the man who travels with the help of the wheel, but a couple of years ago it was a heart that was transported to Kochi for transplantation. The recipient was in Kochi and the donor was in Thiruvananthapuram. Evolution of the wheel made it possible.

In recent times two doctors in Canada, Frederick Banting and Charles Best, discovered insulin, a pancreatic hormone essential for metabolizing carbohydrates, at University of Toronto. Further research ultimately led to isolation and commercial production of insulin and successful treatment of diabetes. Then came recombinant technology. Today millions of diabetic patients survive because insulin is available in plenty.

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“In every one of you there is potential and that potential comes not from your learning in the class room or the lab but by applying that learning for human betterment. As biotechnology students you have the tool to better the life of the people. Don't look at your job just as an occupation but as a way of living. There will be no honour, there will be no salary but you will find happiness in doing things in a different way and finding something to change the world around,” Dr. Easwer concluded.

Presiding over the function, Dr. Radha P Thevannoor, Registrar and Group Director spoke on the need for developing a startup culture among the young scientists. Remarkable teams are the result of such a culture. There are umpteen number of problems in the society, for which we need answers. As researchers your duty is to look around and find solution to some of those problems, she told the students. Referring to the success of Hyderabad-based startup firm manufacturing and marketing high-tech shoes for the visually impaired, Dr. G Sashi Kumar, Principal, SSTM said that the startup ecosystem in India has grown tremendously over the recent past and remains to be one of the most vibrant systems. He was offering felicitations.

Dr. C Mohankumar, Director, SIBB-R&D welcomed the gathering and Dr. C Sethulekshmi Nair, Dy. Director, SIBBR&D proposed the vote of thanks. In the technical session that followed, **Dr. H. Easwer** spoke on his experience in Translation Research, an experience with hydroxyapatite

Dr.K.Manzoor, Sr. Scientist, Molecular Medicines, Amrita Institute of Medical Science spoke on Advance in Cancer Treatment-Nano medicine and immune therapy. In the afternoon session Dr. C.Mohankumar spoke on Processing Technology and Product Development. He presented the research data of two new research projects in SIBBR&D lab. The first one was on the indigenous production technology of Virgin Coconut Oil(VCCO) by cost-effective method standardized by SIBBR&D. The second focus was on the product development of a topical ointment for scar-less wound closure as a herbal cosmetics.

During his talk, he pointed out the unique metabolic pathway of Lauric acid, the primary fatty acid of VCO unlike any other edible oils in human system leading to the production of Ketone bodies that can be transported easily to the blood

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stream and brain cells as a substitute of glucose as cell fuel for curing neuro degenerative disorders.

Regarding the herbal product, Dr. Mohankumar presented the molecular evidence of wound closure treated with HALE(a combination developed by SIBBR&D from a natural herb Hemigraphisalternata)by showing the expression of marker genes of wound healing. The herb Hemigraphis alternate has been traditionally identified in Indian medicine to promote the healing of soft tissue wounds and minor injuries.

In the panel discussion that followed Dr. C.N Narayana, Director, SCMS COCHIN School of Business, Dr.CMohankumar, Dr K.S Rishad, CEO, Klonos Life Sciences, Kochi, Dr.P.RDeepu Krishnan, Chief Scientist Officer, Indriyam Biologics, Thiruvananthapuram, Dr. C Sethulekshmi Nair, and Dr. Harish M., Scientist, SIBBR&D participated.

Report on two weeks AICTE sponsored Faculty Development Programme on 'Data Science and Decision Making Processes'


