COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

By and Between the

ESCUELA DE AGRICULTURA DE LA REGIÓN TROPICAL HÚMEDA

and the

SCMS GROUP OF EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

This agreement is made and entered into by and between the SCMS Group of Educational Institutions, located in Cochin, Kerala, INDIA., herein after referred to as "SCMS" and and the Escuela de Agricultura de la Región Trópical Húmeda, located in Las Mercedes, Guácimo, Limón, Costa Rica, hereafter referred to as "EARTH". The parties hereto agree as follows:

I. Philosophical Intent

a. The primary objective of this agreement is the development of cooperative efforts between SCMS and EARTH, which will enhance the academic exchange between the two institutions. Recognizing the importance of mutual collaboration and the contributions to society made by institutions of higher education, the parties desire to promote exchange between the faculty and students of the two institutions as well as the exchange of academic and research information.

b. Specific projects in an area of educational interest will be selected as a result of coordination by SCMS and EARTH at the appropriate administrative level in each institution. As these projects are developed, each will require a specific written agreement made in advance, setting forth the terms and conditions thereof and executed by authorized representatives of both institutions.

II. General Provisions

a. All research and other collaborative activities conducted pursuant to this agreement shall be conducted in accordance with the laws and regulations appropriate to each institution. In the case of SCMS, these include the


laws of INDIA and Higher Education Department, State of KERALA and the rules and regulations of the SCMS. In the case of EARTH, these are the laws of the Republic of Costa Rica and the rules and regulations of the Escuela de Agricultura de la Región Tropical Húmeda.

b. This agreement shall take effect when executed by the parties and be in effect for Five years. The agreement may be renewed or amended by written mutual agreement. This agreement may be terminated by either party by giving 60 days' written notice to the other party.

c. Notices with respect to this agreement shall be provided to the parties as indicated on Attachment A hereto, entitled "Administration of Program and Contact Information" which is incorporated by reference herein.
