



As part of Swachh Bharat 100 Hours Internship Programme, SCMS School of Technology and Management had taken initiative in undertaking a lot of activities in our premises and schools. All our students along with our faculty members wholeheartedly participated in this mission with a sense of dedication and responsibility.

In order to accomplish the task, students were divided in to five groups with two faculty co coordinators. Three groups were assigned the task of visiting schools and two groups for visiting houses in Panchayaths. They were asked to make a programme chart and were given two days to practice all the activities along with their co coordinators. Our students also took initiative in directing a short film titled 'TRASH CAN 'based on the theme swachhta.

As part of swachhta mission our two groups of students visited Choornikkara panchayath to spread awareness about the importance of personal and public hygiene. In the wake of numerous hazards caused due to pollution and lack of hygiene, the swachhta mission undertaken by Govt of India is an eye-opener for all of us. It is a pleasure and privilege to associate with this mission in our area.

Our students visited more than 100 houses in Choornikkara Panchayath over a span of one week to give the residents an insight to the harms caused by one's ignorance and neglect. Notices were printed and given to all the residents and importance of Swachhta mission was also explained. Different measures that have to be taken for hygiene and prevention of water logging especially during rainy season were explained so as to restrict the spread of various diseases. Waste management techniques like how to segregate plastic and food wastes were also shared amongst the residents.

Door to door campaign was successfully accomplished because of the whole hearted support and hospitality shown by the residents of Choornikkara Panchayath.. They were very keen to know more about the mission and various precautionary measures. For them it was the first of its kind and they supported and congratulated us for taking up this grave yet overlooked issue of our country.

As part of the mission our students cleaned the college premises ,painted walls and planted trees ,all in two days. Swachh Bharat initiative proved to be platform for our students to come together for a national cause of widespread concern.

Our students visited four schools namely Nalanda Public school, Thammanam, HMT Higher Secondary School, Kalamassery, HMT Primary school, Kalamassery and Asoka Primary School, Asokapuram. All the school students participated in all the activities ocluding speeches, Paper bag making, drawing, poster making quiz and skit very enthusias trally. Our deeds and ideas were highly appreciated by the school authorities and they promise a all shelp support in our future endeavors also.

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
