

# Nature and Extent of involvement of Faculty and students in academic affairs/ improvements

To enhance the teaching learning experience, student centric approach is adopted including methods such as experimental learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies. Maximum use of ICT, utilization of resources like NPTEL, YouTube and slide-share is promoted by the institute to have effective teaching learning. To nurture critical thinking, creativity and scientific temper, various methods such as field visits, lab exercises, IMLP, OBT, participation in competitions and projects, providing application oriented assignments are used. Students are provided with academic, personal and psychosocial support through counselling, mentoring, personality development programmes and project guidance.

# Mechanism/ Norms and Procedure for democratic/ good Governance

As a matter of policy the management provides the background of every decision taken for the information of the affected parties. Also policies on various aspects of running of the institution are spelt out through the Prospectus and Manual of Policies for the benefit of the students, parents and faculty. Stakeholders are made aware of the evaluation process and expected learning outcomes through manual of policies, lesson plans uploaded in Linways, periodic publication of internal marks on notice board. The institution collects and analyses data on student performance and learning outcomes and uses it for planning and overcoming barriers of learning

# Student Feedback on Institutional Governance/ Faculty performance

The quality of teaching-learning process is monitored and evaluated by way of on-line student feedback, University exam result assessment, feedback from placement cell, feedback from recruiters and open-house meeting with parents. Feedback from the students also helps in identifying the training needs of faculty.

# Grievance Redressed mechanism for Faculty, staff and students performance

In the event of any grievance faculty and staff are free to approach the Principal and discuss their problems. In the case of students they may bring up their grievances to their faculty counsellorat the first instance. The faculty counselor, if necessary, takes up the issue with the Principal. If the issue has to be taken up with the Management the Principal takes the responsibility to doso.

# **Establishment of Anti Ragging Committee**

Anti-Ragging Committee at SSTM consists of the Principal, Vice Principal, Heads of Department, one faculty member and two student representatives from each department. Ragging is totally prohibited in the institution. If anyone indulges in ragging, he/she will be handed over to the police and the law will take its course. Students are therefore, requested to refrain from indulging in any kind of ragging. Anti-Ragging Committee helps in maintaining a ragging-free campus so that students enjoy their stay

in the campus. The college can proudly say that there has been no ragging incident in the past few years. The committee members are vigilant at any point of time and they are watchful particularly at trigger points like canteen, restrooms and hostel. Committee members are posted during breaks at the trigger points to ensure there is no ragging. The students are made aware of the Anti-Ragging Committee and its policies and whom to approach in case of them being a witness, during the Orientation as a first year student.
