- A total of 130 FDPs were attended by our faculty during the academic year 2021-22.
- We have a full-fledged placement cell functioning at our college. Many reputed corporates and banks have placed our students. During the academic year 2021-22, 166 students from a total of 295 students who passed out were placed in reputed firms. 30 students opted for higher education during this time span. For PG students the minimum salary that is offered is Rs. 3.6 lakhs to Rs. 4 lakhs. For the UG courses the salary that is offered is between 2.5 lakh to 3 lakhs per annum. For all the courses we have tie-up with various companies for internships. Internship provide valuable experience for the students and we encourage students to join good companies. Our placement for PG courses is 80% and for UG courses it is 60%. For UG courses, the students join for higher studied in India and abroad and that is the reason the percentage is 60%. Some of the students join their own family business and some start their own ventures which we support.
