






A talk on 'Mental Health of Students' was held for 5th semester Taxation A and B



"How Technology Changes Our Sense of Right and Wrong".



"Vaccines-A successful shot in the dark?"









'Financial Discipline'



'Teaching in the Covid era'





'Online classes vs Offline classes"








