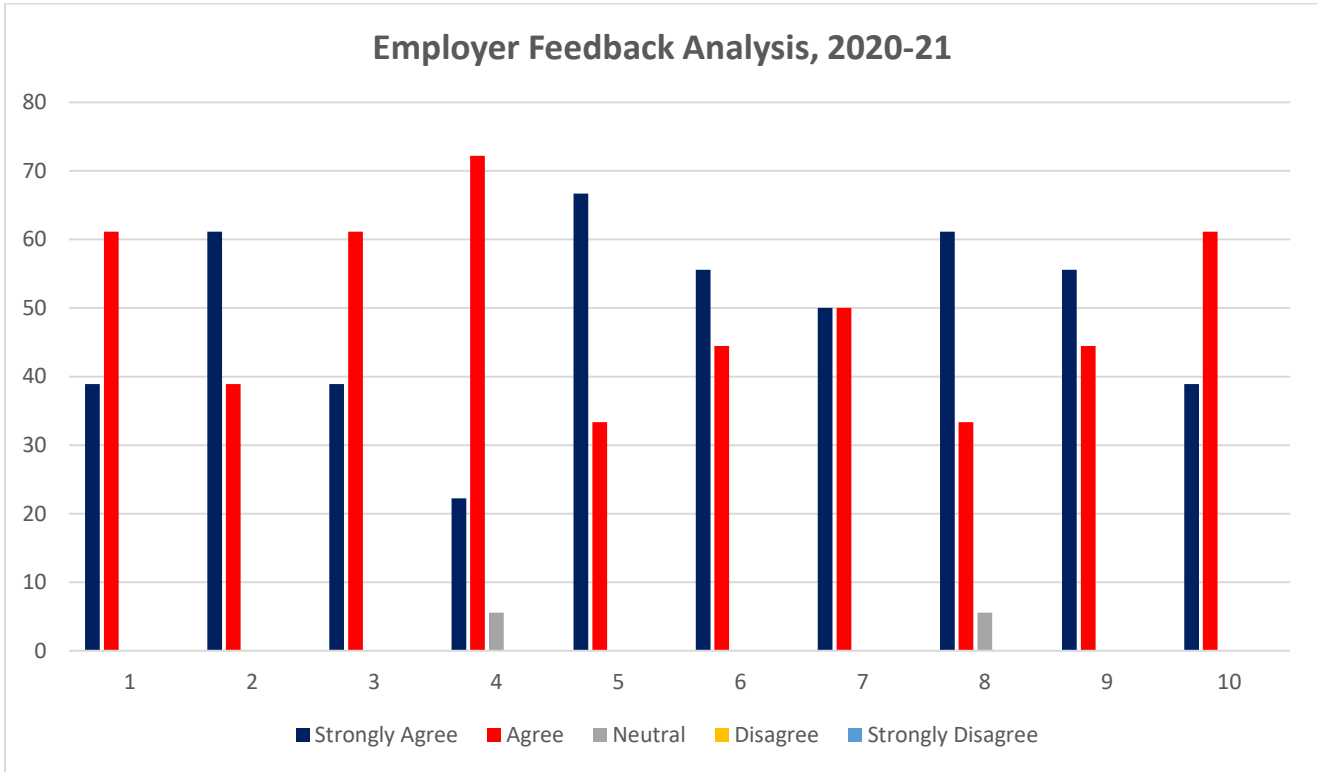
**Employers Feedback:** Employer's feedback is collected and analyzed on the curriculum design and delivery. Based on the feedback received from the employer an analysis is done as follows:
