GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSION

- The research papers must be original and unpublished. Published work is excluded from the Contest. Any paper subsequently published should mention an acknowledgment of the received award.
- The official language for paper writing and presenting is English.
- Only Student research papers will be accepted. It may be co-authored by their faculty guides.
- The work need not be original in engineering content but should be original in treatment and concise in coverage of the author's contribution to the subject.
- The paper must be typewritten on A4 size paper (210 mm × 297 mm), with the text width equal to 183 mm and the text height equal to 243.5 mm; a font size of 10 pt or larger should be used. The two-column IEEE Transactions style (with the space between columns equal to 4.1 mm) is required.
- The paper should not exceed six (6) pages. Over-length papers will not be considered for the contest.
