RATAN TATA: A BENCHMARK FOR INDIAN BUSINESSES

ndia's corporate world mourns the loss of Ratan Naval Tata, the legendary Chairman of Tata Sons. His passing on October 9, 2024, at the age of 86, brings an end to an extraordinary life dedicated to leadership, innovation, and philanthropy.

Ratan Tata joined the Tata Group in 1962 and rose through the ranks to become Chairman of Tata Sons in 1991. Under his visionary leadership he transformed the group into a global conglomerate, with revenues growing over 40 times and profits over 50 times. A renowned philanthropist, he donated around 60-65% of his income to charity, supporting education, medicine, and rural development.

He was a risk taker and in business expanded the group globally with acquisitions like Jaguar Land Rover and Corus Steel. His support to the Indian startup ecosystem is immense. An active angel investor he provided critical funding for young companies across various sectors, especially, tech-driven startups, particularly those leveraging AI, blockchain, healthcare and renewable energy.

Sustainable and socially impactful startups that addressed environmental, social and governance issues too received his support.

He famously said, "I invest in people, not just ideas," disclosing his business style of engaging closely with founders, offering guidance and mentorship. He focused on sustainable growth rather than quick exits.

Ratan Tata was honored with the Padma Vibhushan (2008) and Padma Bhushan (2000) and received many global awards for business excellence and philanthropy.

His passing leaves a void in Indian industry

and his remarkable life serves as a testament to visionary leadership, integrity, and selflessness.

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We at SCMS continue to be inspired by his monumental legacy of leadership, innovation, and philanthropy.
