teachers from Kollam, 14 schools represented by 18 teachers from Thiruvananthapuram, 23 schools represented by 35 teachers from Kozhikode, and 32 schools represented by 37 teachers from Kannur.

The evaluation process aims to identify and shortlist outstanding entries across nine award categories: Best School Award, Best Teacher Team Award, Best Student Project Award, Best Use of Technology and Social Media (Reels), Largest Reach Award (Social Media), Social Impact Award, Best Student-Parent Initiative Award, Best Student Community Project Award, and Celebrity Promotion Video Award.

Capacity Building Program



Capacity building program for driving school instructors and license seekers was conducted at the Uzhavoor Sub Regional Transport Office on May 20, 2026, organized by the SiRST. The programme witnessed the participation of 50 driving instructors and 50 students, aiming to enhance their understanding of vehicle systems and safe driving practices. The sessions focused on key aspects of driving and road safety.

Road Safety Audits

SiRST in collaboration with the Motor Vehicles Department (MVD), conducted two road safety audits on 15 May 2026 aimed at improving road safety and identifying critical traffic issues. The first audit was carried out at Viman Gate, Naval Base, Willingdon Island, with participation from the Cochin

Port Authority and Naval Base officials, focusing on traffic flow, visibility concerns, and safety risks at the junction. The second audit was conducted at the curve near KEL Pulse Power Charging Station, Mamala, Thiruvankulam. The studies identified key safety deficiencies and recommended remedial measures based on established road safety principles and IRC guidelines. The Mamala audit report was submitted to the JRTO, Thripunithura, and the Viman Gate audit report to the Cochin Port Authority for further action.

Corrective Training



As part of ongoing efforts to enhance road safety and encourage responsible driving practices, SiRST in association with IDTR (Institute of Driving, Training and Research), Kerala, conducted a five-day Corrective Training Programme for Drivers from May 18 to 22, 2026 at the SCMS Institute of Multidisciplinary Studies, Perumbavoor with 22 participants. 17 persons participated at the CTD held from June 1 to 5, 2026 at SCMS School of Engineering and Technology (SSET), Karukutty. The programs focused on strengthening their driving competence, safety consciousness, and behavioral skills essential for safe road use. The training incorporated a range of educational sessions covering traffic rules and driver responsibility.
