Abstract: Abstract should be written with 12 font size, Times New Roman, single line spacing. Objective, method and findings must be summarized in this section.

Keywords: This section should contain maximum 5 words, separated by commas.

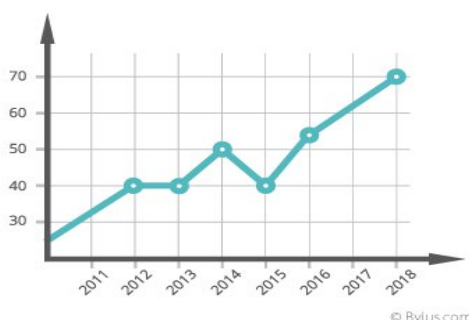
GENERAL GUIDELINES

The full paper should include the following key sections: **Abstract and Keywords, Introduction, Methodology, Findings, Conclusion, and References**. Authors may use alternative section titles where appropriate and may include relevant subsections to enhance clarity and organization.

Manuscripts must be prepared using **Times New Roman, 12-point font size, and single line spacing**. The paper should not exceed **6,000 words**, including tables, figures, photographs, illustrations, and appendices. However, the **reference list is excluded from the word count**. The document should be formatted on **A4-sized paper** with **2.5 cm margins** on all sides (top, bottom, left, and right). Page numbers should not be included.

Authors may incorporate supporting visual materials to present their findings, with a maximum of **two figures (or images) and two tables**. All tables, figures, and images should be **center-aligned** within the document.

Figures and images should be numbered consecutively (e.g., *Figure 1, Figure 2*) with their captions placed **below** the respective figure or image. Tables should also be numbered sequentially (e.g., *Table 1, Table 2*), with their titles positioned **above** the table. Where applicable, the source or reference for each table, figure, or image should be provided immediately below it, citing the **author's surname and year of publication**.

INTRODUCTION (TIMES NEW ROMAN, 12 FONT SIZE, BOLD, ALL CAPS)

The introduction section should (1) present the scope and objective of the paper and state the problem, (2) briefly review the pertinent literature, (3) describe the methods, and (4) provide an overview of the main research results.

METHODOLOGY

The methodology must be clearly stated and described in sufficient detail or with appropriate references. The author shall explain the research question, describe the research framework, and outline the methods applied in detail. This section should highlight why the particular research question is relevant to theory and practice, and why the chosen method(s) is(are) suited to the problem.

FINDINGS

The arguments and findings are described in detail in this section.

CONCLUSIONS

Conclusions should include:

- (1) the principles and generalizations inferred from the results,
- (2) any exceptions, problems or limitations of the work,
- (3) theoretical and/or practical implications of the work, and
- (4) conclusions drawn and recommendations.
